

What is Healing Touch?

Healing Touch (HT) is hands-on energy work that enhances one's own ability to heal. HT for babies can accelerate healing of birth complications, enhance the bonding process and optimize growth in premature babies. This workshop teaches the concepts of clearing, aligning, and balancing an infant's energy system through touch.

This workshop benefits registered nurses, physicians, body therapists, counselors, other health professionals, and individuals desiring an in-depth understanding and practice of healing work using energy based concepts with infants.
